Dear Prof. Dr. Yuksek,

The Department of State Policy in Civil Aviation of the Ministry of Transport of the Russian Federation presents its compliments to the Aeronautical Authorities of the Republic of Turkey and you personally.

In accordance with the letters of the Turkish side, we would like to offer you through an exchange of letters to consolidate a temporary agreement for 2 consecutive IATA Seasons, starting from IATA Summer-2021, as follows:

1. Increase the number of designated air carriers on the route Saint-Petersburg – Istanbul to 2 (two) air carries for each Side, with the limitation of 14 (fourteen) frequencies per week assigned to the first designated air carrier of each Side and 7 (seven) frequencies per week assigned to the second designated air carrier of each Side.
2. Increase the number of designated air carriers on the route Moscow – Antalya to 4 (four) air carries for each Side, with the limitation of 7 (seven) frequencies per week assigned to the fourth designated air carrier of each Side.
3. Reallocate the frequency of flights on the route Istanbul – Moscow as of 9 (nine) frequencies per week assigned to the second designated air carrier of Turkish Side and 5 (five) frequencies per week assigned to the third designated air carrier of Turkish Side.

4. Increase the number of designated air carriers on the route Novosibirsk – Istanbul to 2 (two) air carries for each Side with the limitation of total 7 (seven) frequencies for the route.

The proposed agreement will be temporary and may be suspended in the event of deterioration of the sanitary and epidemiological situation with a corresponding notice.

In case of your agreement, we propose that this letter and your positive response to it to be considered as a temporary agreement between our Aeronautical Authorities.

Due to the instability of the situation with the spread of a new coronavirus infection and uncertainty about the market situation after the removal of restrictions on COVID-19, we believe it is possible to continue negotiations on extension of commercial rights on a permanent basis after the improvement of the sanitary and epidemiological situation.

We hope to continue mutually beneficial cooperation.

Dear Ms. PETROVA,

Turkish Directorate General of Civil Aviation presents its compliments to Department of State Policy in Civil Aviation, Ministry of Transport of the Russian Federation.

We have received your letter dated 22.03.2021 regarding your Authority's temporary agreement proposals for 2 consecutive IATA Seasons, starting from IATA Summer-2021.

In this regard, we agree on:

- 1- increasing the number of designated air carriers for İstanbul-St.Petersburg v.v. to 2 (two) air carriers for each Side, with the limitation of 14 (fourteen) frequencies per week assigned to the first designated air carrier of each Side and 7 (seven) frequencies per week assigned to the second designated air carrier of each Side.
- 2- increasing the number of designated air carriers for Antalya-Moscow v.v. to 4 (four) air carriers for each Side with the limitation of 7 (seven) frequencies per week assigned to the fourth designated air carrier of each Side.
- 3- reallocating the frequency of flights for İstanbul-Moscow v.v. as 9 (nine) frequencies per week assigned to the second designated air carrier of Turkish Side and 5 (five) frequencies per week assigned to the third designated air carrier of Turkish Side.
- 4- increasing the number of designated air carriers for İstanbul-Novosibirsk v.v. to 2 (two) air carriers for each Side with the limitation of total 7 (seven) frequencies for the route.
